He also, as a representative for the choir, attends the Arts Meetings of South Dublin Co. Council. He has attended two so far, which have not been successful or worthwhile. He asked for suggestions from members – one suggestion was to bring back the Sunday concerts to the parks.

A suggestion came from Aidan Knight about getting outdoor tops for choir – considered too costly for limited use.

The banners have been ordered – enabling us to display these when we are doing a concert.
